(a regional district chartered by the state of Montana)

Originally organized in 2000 to protect the water quality of the Missoula Aquifer in the Target Range area.

The District has expanded at the request of residents who live outside the existing District boundaries who feel they would be better served if they were included in the District.

The Target Range Sewer & Water District does not currently intend to install sewer and water lines west of Reserve street. The District's approach is through conservation and wise use of the existing septic and well infrastructure that currently exists in the area.

Since its inception in 2000, the District has been run by committed, residential volunteers.

You can see by our list of goals that it would be impossible to accomplish any of these objectives without proper funding and having leadership in place to coordinate the ever-increasing sewer and water-related issues within the District.



Value Added Services

- The District is a voice of the Target Range people at the City, County and State level.
- The District promotes and provides information for high-efficiency and state-of-the-art septic systems.
- The District shares community planning and protection with the Target Range Homeowners Association.
- Our standard is to maintain water quality levels that meet or exceed federal and state requirements for health and safety.
- We publish a newsletter that includes articles, news, and issues that educate and inform homeowners, saving them time and money in maintaining their property.
- The District Board of Directors is elected from and by the people of Target Range.
- The District Board members and engineering staff conduct field visits with property owners to review and correct sewer problems or answer questions that they may have.

- The District has established a grant program that provides financial assistance to our property owners for upgrades and replacements of their water treatment systems.
- The Board manages our greatest natural resources—WATER.



District has the following goals:

- A localized focus on the issues that are important to residents in the District.
- Conservation of local water resources.
- Protection of the Missoula Aquifer by encouraging and preserving low housing densities.
- Education - Mailings to residents on proper septic use, maintenance and replacement.

- Monitoring and testing of ground water and septic systems.
- Monitoring of the sewer and water issues for future planned developments.
- Recommendations for improved septic and waste water treatment systems.
- Replacement of cesspools with septic systems and assisted funding by grants to property owners.
- We are currently contracting NewFields Companies, LLC, to assess water quality of the aquifer within the boundaries of the District, evaluate the susceptibility of groundwater in the area to water quality impacts, and delineate risk areas for potential impacts.
